Still need a copy of the demolition bond, the Select Board will approve it when it arrives. The board then went through the FOF requirements. All 17 requirements were deemed met by votes of 5-0. K. Colwell made a motion to approve the application with following conditions: within 14 days the applicant must provide (1) the letter of credit for the demolition bond with the Town as the beneficiary and with the 5 year renewals, (2) copies of the easements for the power lines, and (3) copy of the land lease. N. Branca seconded and the motion passed 5-0.

FOF Subdivision Review

This review is required because this project involves three different lots and thus is classed as a subdivision.

The Board went through the 21 questions in the review and all were answered satisfactorily. All questions passed by votes of 5-0. K. Colwell made a motion to approve the Subdivision Review Application with two conditions: (1) no permanent buildings or dwellings may be erected without prior approval of the Planning Board and (2) the applicant will meet all of the conditions outlined in the Site Plan Review FOF. The motion was seconded by N. Branca. The motion passed 5-0.
