Article 1: To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting. Nomination opened at 6:00pm. *Motion to nominate Jack Bridges, as the moderator by Adam Foster, second by Bill Birdsall, no other nominations. Nominations closed. Approval of nomination passed. Oath signed.*

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$12,751.06 (amount remaining) from the American Rescue Plan money and to pay any remaining amount out of Town Hall Revitalization Account in the following manner:


Motion to pay the above expenditures as presented, seconded, passed.

Motion to adjourn at 6:03pm, seconded, passed.




