You are hereby notified that a Special Town Meeting in this municipality will be held at the Hancock Town Office, 18 Point Road in Hancock at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 15, 2023 for the purpose of determining the following articles:

Article 1: To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Motion to nominate Jack Bridges as moderator by Sean Jones, second by Adam Foster, passed.

**Article 2**: To see if the Town will vote to approve the following definition additions to the Environmental Control Ordinance:

DEFINITION <u>ADDITIONS/CHANGES</u> TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL ORDINANCE:

Section 12: Definitions

**TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS VI**: (short term rentals in hotels, motels and inns) Building providing accommodations for compensation, where guest rooms are provided for a period of 30 days or less.

**TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS VII:** (long term rentals in hotels, motels and inns) Buildings providing accommodations for compensation, where guest rooms are provided for a period of 31 days or longer. Each guest room must include a kitchen area and bathroom with a minimum of 400sf (square feet).

**CHANGES** TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL ORDINANCE:

TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS VI TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS VIII:

Section 12 – Definitions: Current

**TRANSIENT:** A non-resident person residing within the Town less than thirty (30) days.

## Section 12 – Definitions: New (Proposed change)

**TRANSIENT:** A non-resident person working or visiting within the Town. The Registrar of Voters will be available ½ hour prior to the meeting to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list and to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote, and to accept new enrollments.

A discussion was held regarding the changes.

Motion to approve the changes as submitted and written by Katerine Colwell Small, second by Chris Holmes, passed. One opposed.

The Registrar of Voters will be available ½ hour prior to the meeting to correct any errors in or change a name or address on the voting list and to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote, and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election or town meeting.
