Once granted this permit is non-transferable and is for use by the boat described above only, any other use must be approved by the Harbormaster. Mooring owner is responsible for all mooring equipment and vessel while moored. Mooring must be inspected upon initial installation and every three years by an approved mooring inspector. Failure to pay registration or any unauthorized use of the mooring shall be grounds for loss of mooring privilege. All moorings must have the permit number permanently displayed on the mooring float in contrasting color in minimum three (3) inch numbers. The Harbormaster shall assign the locations of all moorings within the Town of Hancock and adjacent waters as authorized by the Harbor Ordinance. All moorings must meet minimum weight and size specifications for the series mooring being established. Mooring standards are contained in the Town Harbor Ordinance.

MAINE STATE LAW REQUIRES A MINIMUM LOT SIZE OF 20,000 SQ. FEET AND A MINIMUM WATER FRONTAGE OF 100 FEET IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A RIPARIAN MOORING. Persons owning water frontage before January 1, 1987 need only meet the 100 foot frontage requirement.
