

MINUTES OF THE PLANNING BOARD'S DEC. 6 SITE VISIT TO ELLIOTT JORDAN & SON'S WYMAN ROAD GRAVEL PIT

Present: Doug Kimmel, Ken Emerson, Meredith Akerstein, Ant Blasi, Stephen Salsbury

Doug Kimmel called the meeting to order at 10:05.

Steve Salsbury showed the 10-acre site and pointed out the two wells on the site, where gravel and other materials would be stockpiled, and the hillocks that will eventually be leveled.

He explained that processing would be conducted on-site. Meredith Akerstein asked what steps would be taken to reduce the dust that processing creates. Ant Blasi noted that Hancock's ordinances require such steps be taken. Steve said he would inquire about this and report back.

An unoccupied building on the premises is being cleaned out to serve an undetermined purpose.

Steve said that after the gravel is extracted, Jordan & Son expects to use or sell the land for other industrial, commercial and/or residential purposes. Otherwise its reclamation plan will return the site to a natural state.

Doug said that because the site is on a major aquifer, adjacent Ellsworth and Lamoine must be apprised of the application.
